# 2012 Tournament Rules .

**RULE 1 – ELIGIBILITY** – All individuals who are members of the S.J. USBC B.A . certified through U.S.B.C. for the 2011-2012 season are eligible to bowl in this tournament. Grade and high school students who have not attained the age of 18 must have written consent of their parents or guardian in order to compete in this tournament. Such written consent must be on a form approved by the USBC and must be on file with the tournament chairman at least one week before the bowler is eligible to compete, unless accompanied by his parent or guardian in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the bowler starts to bowl. Non-members of this association who live in our area may enter by paying for an unattached card for \$20.00 and will use a 230 average.

**All bowlers must have purchased their SJ USBC BA card, 30 days before the start of the tournament (February 2 ,2012) There will be both Scratch and handicapped divisions cashing in each divisions in**

**NOTE** – This association will limit the **number** of **PBA** members to **two** on a Five-Man team and to **one** on a Two-Man event. It is the responsibility of the team captain to note on the entry form who the **PBA** members are. Failure to do so could cause disqualification and forfeiture of entry fee.

**RULE 2 – AVERAGES** – All averages used in this tournament must have been established in a **certified league** through the **South Jersey USBC Bowling Association**. Each entrant's average shall be used in the following order:

- A. **Highest 2010-2011 average in any league where entrant bowled at least 21 games per average book, May 1, 2011. (Summer average only if no winter average. If you do not have more than 30 games, proof of league average last three years to be re-rated by tournament director)**
- B. **If no 2010-2011 average, bowler will use his highest sanctioned league average as of JANUARY 1, 2012 based on a minimum of 21 games. IF A BOWLER HAS A HIGHER AVERAGE IN ANOTHER BOWLING ASSOCIATION, HE OR SHE MUST DECLARE IT OR ALL GAMES WILL BE FORFEITED! (COULD BE RE-RATED.)**
- C. **Entrants with neither of the above qualifications must use 230.**
- D. **The tournament manager, prior to the entrant's bowling, may assign a higher average than the forgoing in accordance with USBC Rule 319C when information indicates the individual may be a better bowler. USBC Rule 319A** Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. If submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicaps, the bowler's score is disqualified. **If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.** Tournament manager reserves the right to re-rate entry prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the re-rate, entry fees will be refunded. Entrants have the right to appeal any re-rate to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. If you use **USBC Rule 2-B** of average rule, you must send proof of average signed by your league secretary with this entry form. This tournament will use the previous season's averages. **Rule 319D** requires all bowlers to report their previous tournament prize winnings over \$300.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12-month period for possible re-rating. All tournament rules from the United States Bowling Congress Rule Book will be used in this tournament.
- E. **Rule 319A2 is waived.**

**RULE 3 – SUBSTITUTES** – A substitute whose name and average is not shown on the entry blank, and who can meet eligibility requirements shall use averages in the same order as shown under Rule 2. No substitute will be accepted for All-Events prize participation when any one event, or portion of an event, has been bowled by either the original entrant or the substitute. It is the bowler's responsibility to notify tournament director when he or she is bowling all 9 games as a replacement bowler.

**RULE 4 – HANDICAP** – The handicap shall be on a per game base and shall be 100% of the difference between the scratch figure and the total of the averages for each event in accordance with the following table:

**Masters Champion the top 4 bowlers in the Masters will bowl 1 GAME FOR POSITION ROUND**

**ONE WINNER WILL BE CROWNED MASTER CHAMPION 4 will bowl 3 winner bowl 2 winner bowls 1for championship.**

**RULE 5 – ALL-EVENTS** – The All-Events shall be conducted in three divisions on an actual score basis only, as follows:

**CLASS A:** Entrants with an average of 200 or higher.

**CLASS B:** Entrants with an average of 186-199

**CLASS C:** Entrants with an average of 0-185

Entrant's average under the Tournament rules determines the class he must bowl in. Participation in the All-Events Prize List is optional upon payment of an entry fee of \$15.00 per man. Should a non-paying participant win either division of the All-Events, he will receive the championship award and the official title, but no cash prize (**USBC Rule 306C**). 1<sup>st</sup> score in doubles will count towards the total.

**RULE 6 – CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITY** – The individual whose name appears on the entry blank as team captain shall be responsible for the accuracy of all information submitted on the entry blank including the order in which his team will bowl. Any information submitted incorrectly may result in disqualification of the entry and forfeiture of all prize, bowling and expense fees. All teams or individuals must bowl on lanes assigned to them or forfeit their entry fee.

**RULE 7 – ENTRY LIMIT** – A: When three or more members of a Five-Man Team already entered in the South Jersey Bowling Association Tournament bowl together on another Five-Man Team, they can place only once in the prize list for gross and position standing. A bowler may bowl in the Five-Man Team Event as often as he desires with no limitations except as noted in part (A) of the rule. If a bowler competes more than once in the Five-Man Team Event, his first series shall count toward his All-Events score. No one may compete more than once in the singles.

**Doubles will allow 2<sup>nd</sup> entry with another partner on MARCH 17, 2012 – 11:00 a.m. only. One of partners must have already bowled doubles**

**RULE 8 – TERMINATION, PREMATURE** – Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or wherefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the South Jersey Bowling Association shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.

**RULE 9 – NO UNREASONABLE DELAY** – USBC Rule 11, the tournament officials shall allow no unreasonable delay in the progress of any game. Should any member or team participating in this tournament refuse to proceed with the game after being directed to do so by the proper authorities, such game or series shall be declared forfeited. **Once tournament starts missing bowler will take 0 for each frame missed.**

**RULE 10 – FINAL AVERAGE SHEETS** on file with the SJ USBC BA will be the official average for use in this tournament if league secretaries did not submit final average sheets in time for inclusion in the Average Book. If there is no final sheet on file, bowlers must follow Rule 2B or 2C above.

**RULE 11 – Bowlers must have a collared shirt with sleeves while bowling !!!!**

**RULE 12 – All decisions of the Tournament Manager are FINAL unless an appeal is made in accordance with U.S.B.C. Rule 329.**

**RULE 13 – PRIZE MONEY** – All prize fees collected in an event or division of an event will be returned 100% to the participants in that event or division of that event, as per **USBC RULE 308**.

**RULE 14 ANY ONE WHO WINS \$600.00 OR MORE in ANY SJBA TOURNAMENTS WILL RECEIVE A 1099 FORM**
