

# Hall of Fame

## Point System

The Hall of Fame point system is designed for use as an aid to prospective candidates during the screening process of biographies submitted to the Hall of Fame Committee.

It is recommended that biographies formally submitted to the committee be prepared in a structured manner, listing credentials chronologically by local, state & national level. (Use Hall of Fame application form if possible.)

Additional information, not covered on the respective point system chart, should be listed separately.

Furthermore, candidates submitting biographies should have the following minimum point totals for that biography to be submitted to the Hall of Fame Committee for their consideration:

Bowling Achievement Category ..... 175 Points  
Meritorious Service Category ..... 125 Points  
Veterans Category .....(See Basic Criteria)

To be eligible for the Bowling Achievement Category of the SJBA Hall of Fame, a candidate must have participated in the South Jersey Annual Championships for a minimum of 10 years.

To be eligible for the Meritorious Service and/or Veterans Category of the SJBA Hall of Fame, a candidate must have bowled in the Annual SJBA Championships at least 10 years and his/her achievements must span a minimum of 10 years.

## **Bowling Achievement Category**

Minimum requirement – 175 points

Maximum number of inductions per year 2

**Promotion** - Maximum 10 Points

Describe in detail any contributions to the sport of bowling. Include service rendered to the South Jersey BA, NJ State BA, or the National Organization.

List league activities including offices held, organization and sanctioning efforts, and all other information pertinent to service record.

DO NOT INCLUDE INFORMATION WHERE POINTS WERE GIVEN FROM ABOVE CHART.

Other consideration can be given for sponsors of teams in any SJBA Championship Tournament or league play. Minimum 10 years. Must be with Committee approval.

## **Veterans Category**

### **Basic Criteria**

Because of the age requirement, points will not be used in the selection process.

The candidate must meet the following minimum requirements for consideration:

1. Must be at least 60 years of age.
2. Must have at least 15 years of bowling within the jurisdiction of the South Jersey Bowling Association.
3. Must have a 10 year composite average of at least 190 in the South Jersey Bowling Association.
4. Must show outstanding achievement prior to 1985 on the local, state or national levels.

All information submitted on behalf of a candidate, should be validated where possible, by the sponsoring person prior to submission to the Hall of Fame Committee.
